Nancy writes that she first started the process with her team and developed it over time with many clients. Refining and improving what became a 'Thinking Environment'.

There are simple steps to follow: Listening without interruption, Identifying assumptions, Allowing the Thinker to release ideas etc and, the reinforcement of the value of positive thinking is really well explained.

Essentially, the book is engaging and instructive with a good number of anecdotes to make it interesting and fun to read.


How did this book impact me?
